Rev. Ho Kee Chung writes...

Gaze at the bright moon and Think about God's Love

"When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them? You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. (Psalm 8:3-5)

On Mid-Autumn night, when we lift our eyes to the full moon, which was created by God, our hearts are often stirred by its beauty and tranquility. This reminds me of Psalm 8, where David gazes at the moon and stars under the night sky, and his heart is awakened, marvelling at God's greatness and being deeply moved by God's great love for man. He wrote: "When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?" (Psalm 8:3-4). Looking at the moon not only reminds us of the vastness of the universe, but also makes us aware of our own smallness. Despite our smallness, God cares for us with His infinite grace. He knows each of us by name, cares for our weaknesses and needs, and sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to earth to lay down His life for us and show His sacrificial love.
