Kaltara Prayer and Worship Conference

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing." (2 Thessalonians 1:3)

My heart deeply resonates with this passage of gratitude following my time in Seimenggaris from July 6–8 for the Kaltara Prayer and Worship Conference. Nearly 300 participants from all our Anglican churches across North Kalimantan gathered for this powerful three-day event, themed “Surrender All.”

This conference was entirely organized by our Indonesian leadership team. As I observed the event unfold, I was filled with immense gratitude seeing their growth, maturity, unity, and unwavering commitment. They worked tirelessly, managing every detail to ensure everything ran smoothly, and went the extra mile to care for both participants and speakers. The standard of organization truly matched that of any major city-run event!

A few moments from the week deeply touched my heart:

Generous Sacrificial Giving: To keep registration fees low for outstation participants traveling from Tarakan, Nunukan, Tanjong Selor, Malinau, and Seikalayan, local members stepped up to cover the budget shortfall. In a beautiful display of creative generosity, some members even allowed the organizers to harvest their oil palm crops, donating all the proceeds to the conference fund. Simply Amazing!

The Faithfulness of the Mothers: Our catering was carried out by dozens of dedicated women who took turns preparing, cooking, and cleaning. Arriving as early as 4:30am and returning home late into the night, their hard work ensured that delicious food and drinks were always abundant. No one went to bed hungry!
