Rector writes...



Mission *Final Kick-Off*

"I urge you, brothers and sisters, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle (mission) by praying to God for me. Pray that I may be kept safe from the unbelievers in Judea and that the contribution I take to Jerusalem may be favorably received by the Lord's people there." (Romans 15:30–31)

Every four years, the world stops for a moment. With the stadium packed with millions glued to 22 players, with the blowing of the whistle - all the years of grueling training and planning set into motion. *It's the final Kick-Off!*

This weekend, we are not just watching a World Cup kickoff; **we are living one.** We are kicking-off a massive, spirit-led campaign. 209 of our SPC members are stepping onto the harvest fields, with 19 teams to 16 churches across 6 different countries. Just like a football team representing their homeland on the world stage, our short-term mission teams are stepping out as ambassadors of a far greater Kingdom.

To win a match, a team needs more than just enthusiasm; they need a game plan. As our team step into the field, we are supporting them in prayer in three vital areas: peak condition, great teamwork, and flawless execution!

1. Peak Conditioning (Good Health). Let us pray for protection, stamina, and resilience for all our 209 members. Pray against sickness, fatigue or injuries so they can be at their absolute best in their mission. A few members have withdrawn due to unforeseen circumstances. Let us continue to pray for covering and protection upon members and their loved ones.

2. Unbreakable Chemistry (Great Teamwork). World Cup is never won by a single player. Likewise, we pray for unity, understanding and mutual encouragement among the teams. Let their love for one another be a primary witness to the 14 host churches.

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3. Flawless Execution (Good Program Delivery). Lots of preparation have been put in over the months e.g. Sermons, workshops, lesson plans, even cooking demonstration. We pray that every program runs smoothly, and that the Holy Spirit breathes life into every planned event.

But here is the most crucial part of the World Cup parallel: *Teams do not play in empty stadiums.* The Roar of the Crowd fuels them! Fans don't just watch - *they participate!* They cheer, they chant, they hold up banners and celebrate every single goal as if they scored it themselves.

Likewise, as our 209 brothers and sisters step on to the fields, we will be their fans surrounding them – with our prayers being the greatest roar of support that will carry them through the mission. Let's make some noise in the spiritual realm - knowing that when they win ground for the Kingdom, we all win together.
