Area Diocese of Sabah South (ADOS~S) Leaders' Retreat

Don't you have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. (John 4:35)

We praise God that The Leaders' Retreat of ADOS-S was a great successfully run despite electricity disruptions throughout the two-and-a-half-day event. The Retreat started on 14 September (Sunday) evening and ended on 16 September (Tuesday) noontime. Leaders primarily clergy and PCC truly experienced a "warm" fellowship, establishing new friendships and partnerships throughout ADOS-South region from Tungku, Silabukan, Lahad Datu, Kunak, Semporna, Tawau, Merotai, Kalabakan, Sapulut and Nabawan.

The theme of this first Retreat is "Lift Up Your Eyes". ADOS-South Suffragan Bishop John Yeo gave an overview and challenges of the work of the region and shared the desired goals for the next five years including raising more workers, planting new churches, multiplying Mission Districts and establishing new Mission Archdeaconry in North Kalimantan. Bishop Yeo also encourages all churches to be financially strong and be less dependent on central (Diocese) support to expand God's kingdom. Among the immediate goal is to have all churches to set up their own building and maintenance committees to ensure all churches are well-kept and conducive for ministries. The Retreat are further graced by two important sessions on Finance and Building/Maintenance presented by our own PCC members i.e. Mr. Mauming Singkung and Mr. Ho Ken Kong.

1. Awake! Take refuge in the Faithful God (Psalm 5	7:1-6))

- In suffering, lean on God, not on your own wisdom (vv. 1-2)
- Pain is temporary, but God's faithfulness is eternal (vv. 3-6)

2. Awake! My soul shall worship the Lord (Psalm 57:1-11)

• A spirit awakened to praise God, not to remain in self-pity

- 1. When you go through the valleys of life, what spiritual insights or lessons have you gained from them?
- 2. When choosing to worship in the midst of suffering, what is the hardest part? How do you usually face it?
