Pentecost Sunday

Mission in the Power of the Holy Spirit

Acts 13:1-12

“When the day of Pentecost came, they (disciples) were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. **All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.**”

(Acts 2:1-4)

1. Be Assured of the Holy Spirit’s Presence

Acts 13:2 - While they were worshipping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.”

2. Be Assured of the Holy Spirit’s Empowering

*Acts 13:3-4 - So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. The two of them, **sent on their way by the Holy Spirit**, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus.*
