Rector writes...

Medan Mission Team Experience

Upon arriving in Antioch, they called the church together and reported everything God had done through them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles, too. (Acts 14:27)

From July 18 to 23, 2026, SPC sent out her very first short-term mission exposure team to Medan. Though one member was forced to withdraw due to unforeseen circumstances, the 24-member team faithfully carried out the call.

Throughout the week, the team engaged in a vibrant range of ministries:

Confirmation Service: Joined the confirmation service for 25 members from 4 Anglican churches in Medan and presented a dance performance.

Worship & Fellowship: Led "A Night of Worship" alongside local Anglican churches, presented a dance performance, and visited and prayed for a number of local church families.

Outreach: Conducted a children's ministry outreach and hosted a special "Sabah Food" cooking lesson to build bridges within the local community.

Every team member returned with personal stories of God's goodness and profound lessons learned on the field. Here are three testimonies from the trip:

Key Truth: The greatest spiritual battles are fought in the mind, but God has given believers divine weapons to demolish lies, destroy strongholds, and bring every thought into obedience to Christ.
