Rev. Ho Kee Chung writes...

"Awake My Soul" Psalm Sermon Series

"Awake, my soul! Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn. I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples. For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth." (Psalm 57:8-11)

We have just begun our new sermon series the book of Psalms, "Awake My Soul". This series will explore selected psalms from the book until the end of November. Psalms, a collection of 150 songs and prayers, were written by various authors, primarily King David and other worship leaders like Asaph and the sons of Korah. It has been regarded as the book of worship because it teaches us not to ignore our pain nor let it define our lives. Instead, we should come to God honestly and prayerfully, expressing praise and lamentation to put our hope in God as the people of faith.

That's why we've chosen these psalms. We believe they will speak to our souls, awakening us to worship and trust in God, as King David prayed in Psalm 57:8 - "Awake, my soul! Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn." Even as David fled from Saul's armies, he didn't keep hiding in a cave. Instead, he spoke to his soul, urging it to awaken and put his hope in God.

As we enter the second half of this Year of Awakening, I encourage each of you to pray the same prayer as David did every morning. May our souls and hearts be awakened from our spiritual sleepiness, ready to fulfil God's call. If we are currently facing struggles and difficulties, let these psalms bring comfort and strength, awakening us to rise above the storms through God's grace and mercy, "for His love is great, reaching to the heavens, and his faithfulness reaches to the skies".
